

Postdoctoral position in bacterial pathogenesis

A NIH-funded postdoctoral scholar position is available to study the genetics and virulence mechanisms of *Borrelia burgdorferi*, the Lyme disease spirochete (http://www.ecu.edu/cs-dhs/microbiology/fac_Motaleb.cfm). The project will provide an opportunity for the candidate to develop and implement new ideas to study disease progression caused by the spirochete. In addition, he/she will be part of a dynamic group of scientists working with a wide range of host-pathogen models. The ideal candidate should have a Ph.D. (or equivalent) degree in microbial genetics, molecular biology or a related field. Experience working with animals is desired, but not required.
